The department provides comprehensive pharmacy services to acute care and ambulatory care patients. Drug distribution is highly automated with robotic technology, decentralized automated dispensing machines, and fax scanning technology. A new pharmacy system, bar code medication administration, and CPOE enhance the pharmacist's patient care role.
