It's the largest pharmacy recruiting event where employers and job seekers can meet and interview in one convenient location. PPS is not just for job seekers; it's a well-known venue for PGY-1 and PGY-2 residencies and pharmacy industry fellowships.

How does it work?

Using the PPS section on careerpharm.com you'll be able to post your resume, search for potential employers and programs and set up interviews. If you're undecided about whether you want to pursue a residency or job—post two resumes (for the price of one) and you'll double your visibility.
